





HOLY BAPTISM

Presentation and Examination of the Candidates

Celebrant

The Candidates for Holy Baptism will now be presented.

Parents and Godparents

I present Hadley Grace Raynor, Sarah Jessie Raynor and Heather Michelle Jacobson to receive the Sacrament of Baptism.



The Celebrant asks the parents and godparents:

Will you be responsible for seeing that the child you present is brought up in the Christian faith and life?

Parents and Godparents

I will, with God's help.

Celebrant

Will you by your prayers and witness help this child to grow into the full stature of Christ?

I will, with God's help.



Then the Celebrant asks the following questions of the parents and godparents, who speak on behalf of the child.

Question Do you renounce Satan and all

the spiritual forces of wickedness

that rebel against God?

Answer I renounce them.

Question Do you renounce the evil powers

of this world which corrupt and

destroy the creatures of God?

Answer I renounce them.



Question Do you renounce all sinful desires

that draw you from the love of

God?

Answer I renounce them.

Question Do you turn to Jesus Christ and

accept him as your Savior?

Answer I do.



Question Do you put your whole trust in

His grace and love?

Answer I do.

Question Do you promise to follow and

obey Him as your Lord?

Answer I do.

Thanksgiving over the Water

The Celebrant blesses the water, first saying:

Celebrant

We thank you, Almighty God, for the gift of water. Over it the Holy Spirit moved in the beginning of creation. Through it you led the children of Israel out of their bondage in Egypt into the land of promise. In it your Son Jesus received the baptism of John and was anointed by the Holy Spirit as the Messiah, the Christ, to lead us, through his death and resurrection, from the bondage of sin into everlasting life.



We thank you, Father, for the water of Baptism. In it we are buried with Christ in his death. By it we share in his resurrection. Through it we are reborn by the Holy Spirit. Therefore in joyful obedience to your Son, we bring into his fellowship those who come to him in faith, baptizing them in the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.



At the following words, the Celebrant touches the water

Now sanctify this water, we pray you, by the power of your Holy Spirit, that those who here are cleansed from sin and born again may continue for ever in the risen life of Jesus Christ our Savior.

To him, to you, and to the Holy Spirit, be all honor and glory, now and for ever.

Amen.

PRAYER OF SPIRITUAL COMMUNION


Prayed by those worshipping remotely
